## WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Marilyn Remark specializes in the varietals of France's Rhone Valley. The 2007 Roussanne represents our second vintage working with this rare grape. The fruit for this wine came from the Loma Pacific vineyard in central Monterey County. The grapes were hand harvested in September of 2007 at an average 25 degrees Brix. The juice was pressed directly to stainless steel tanks for fermentation and then aged in French Oak.

The '07 M.R. Roussanne demonstrates true varietal character: aromas and flavors Bartlett pears, apples, and pineapple with hints of nutmeg, vanilla, and toast.

The wine has a great mouthfeel and a good backbone of acidity, finishing crisply. This elegant white is the perfect accompaniment to almost any shellfish dish, as well as spicy Asian-Fusion cuisine. With proper cellaring, this special Roussanne should drink well now through 2010.
